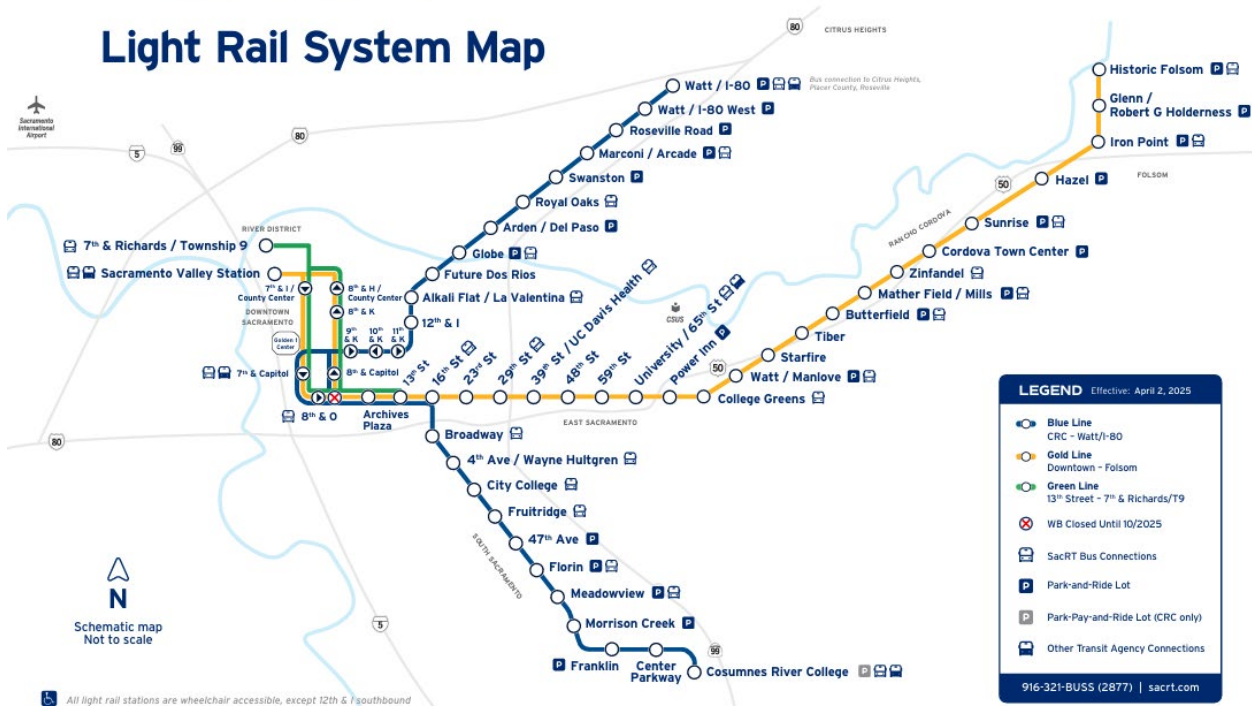
• On-Street Parking –Meteor, Time-Limited or Free depending on area and signage

• Sacramento Regional Transit

- LightRail System consists of two mainlines: Gold Line (Historic Folsom to Sacramento Valley Station) and the Blue Line (Watt I-80 to Consumnes River College) -Single Ride Ticket \$2.50

Name	Location	Description
California State Capitol	1315 10 th Street, Sacramento, CA 95814	A must see for all lovers of architecture and state history is the State Capitol. After 14 years of construction, the California State Capitol was completed in 1840 and has undergone many additions and restorations. Today, visitors can tour the State Capitol for free, Monday through Friday.
Old Sacramento Waterfront	1014 2 nd street #200, Sacramento CA 95814	A historic district on the Sacramento River, featuring Gold Rush-era buildings, wooden sidewalks, museums (like the Railroad Museum), unique shops, restaurants, and attractions like the Delta King riverboat, offering a step back in time with Gold Rush charm, riverfront views, and a mix of history, shopping, and entertainment. It's a National Historic Landmark known for its well-preserved 19th-century structures and significance as the western terminus of the Pony Express and Transcontinental Railroad.
A's Games at Sutter Park	400 Ballpark Dr, West Sacramento CA	Take in one of America's favorite pastimes and catch a baseball game at Sutter Park, home to the Athletics (A's) and the Sacramento Rivercats. https://www.sutterhealthpark.com/
B Street Theater (The Sofia)	2700 Capitol Avenue, Sacramento, CA 95816	Established in 1991, B Street Theater is a place of community and professional theatre. The show "Working for Crumbs" will be available June 17 through July 12 th https://bstreettheatre.org/
Downtown Commons (DOCO)	405 K street, Sacramento	DOCO is a place for community, bringing people together to experience a mix of food and shopping, sports and entertainment, hospitality, and public art, conveniently located in the heart of downtown Sacramento. Here you can find a local movie theatre, restaurants, bars and the Golden 1 Arena.
Crocker Art Museum	216 O street, Sacramento CA	As the first public art museum west of the Mississippi, the Crocker Arts Museum was established in 1885. Another historic site for visitors to see when visiting Sacramento. Open Wed-Sun, 10am-5pm. Admission \$15

California State Railroad Museum (Old Sacramento Area)	125 I street, Sacramento CA	Located in Old Sacramento's Waterfront Area, the Sacramento Railroad Museum offers a fun and interactive experience for Locomotive enthusiasts and history buffs. Open daily, 10AM-5PM. Admission \$12
Coin- Op Game Room	908 K street, Sacramento CA 95814	Offers old- school arcade games, beer, and pizza, wings, etc.
Tipsy Putt	630 K street #120, Sacramento CA 95814	Below ground, creative indoor mini golf & Sports Bar. Offers a verity of beer, wine and a few ciders.
Drake's: The Barn	985 Riverfront Street, West Sacramento CA 95691	Outdoor gathering place with a beer garden, pizzeria & 3 stages hosting DJs & live music shows.
K Street	Between 7 th and 13 th Street	A lively stretch of night life entertainment, bars, and eateries can be found on the K Street strip.
